





Background:-

The spread of novel corona virus in India has created panic in the country and has caused extensive damage to the economy. After the first confirmed positive case reported on January 30 in Kerala, the pandemic has reached many other cities in the country, infecting several thousand people. At present positive cases have been identified in 19 states, and the situation is being monitored by the Central and State Governments with extreme caution.

A total lockdown was announced on the 23rd of March 2020 to be continued till the 3rd of May 2020, to enable the communities to practice social distancing and to stay at home to avoid spreading of the infection further.

The Government of Tamil Nadu has also pressed into service its entire machinery for the prevention and control of the infection. Despite its concerted efforts, the state has witnessed a surge in the number of cases that have started appearing in almost all the districts. The Government is working on replicating the best practices tried and tested across the world such as contact tracing, containment, isolation, and treatment. This strategy will help in flattening the curve. The Government has also started implementing a number of relief measures to protect the poor and the vulnerable households such as direct cash transfer, enhanced rations etc. The migrant labours have been provided with safe shelter and are well-taken care of with food and other amenities.

REAL has encouraged its community leaders to take lead in spreading the awareness at the village level and in social fencing of the villages

1. Distribution of Family Essential Kit:

During the lockdown situation, all the shops were closed and people could not access food and other essential materials and they also could not able to afford to pay for those essentials. 6. Volunteers:

REAL invited youth volunteers to engage in the distribution process and awareness-raising. There were 75 volunteers who participated in the covid response initiatives.

Processes:

The process of Village & beneficiaries selection: -

The team has given priority to the most backward villages for the distribution. After the village selection, a survey was conducted to select beneficiaries. The ration card details of the possible beneficiaries were acquired with the permission of the village panchayat and cross-verification was done by a monitoring committee to ensure the authenticity of the beneficiary. The list was finalized through this rigorous process.

Subsequently, the beneficiaries were requested to produce their ration card copy (xerox) upon which the organization seal and the beneficiary signature were imprinted for authentication. The token number was mentioned on the same document and was handed back to the beneficiaries.

The team prioritized to include the most vulnerable people like SC, ST, Tribals, People with disability, Widows, Small Farmers etc.

Government Approval & Permission:

All necessary approvals were sought as per the guidelines proposed by the State Government with regard to relief distribution. The request letter was submitted to the concprned officials to implement the relief activities in their jurisdiction. After getting approval, the distribution of relief kits to the beneficiaries and awareness creation on the prevention of corona virus and government.

Similarly, we approached the Director of Education to solicit their support to communicate local school Head Masters about the Education and Hygiene kit to the students from 8th to 10th standard. With the liaison with the Government Departments well established with the previous relief
